MUSIC BOOSTERS & MUSIC

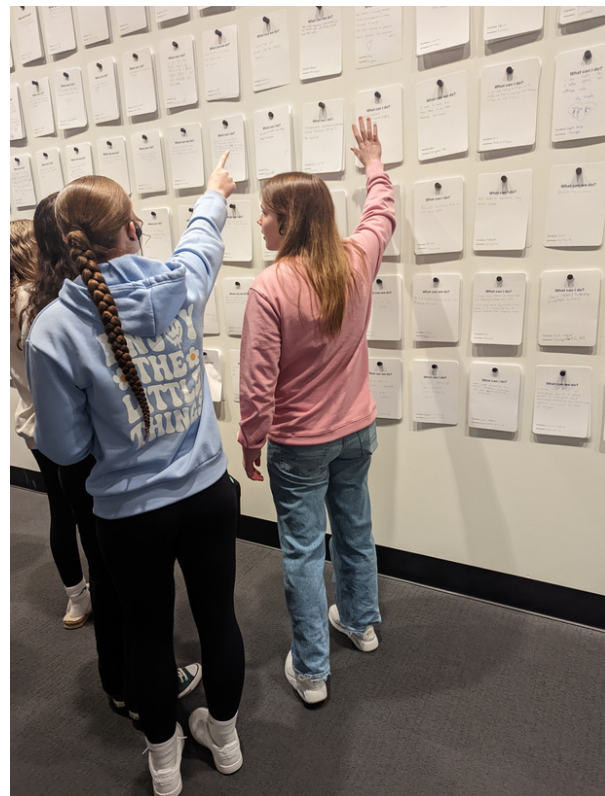
Music Boosters meetings are the second Tuesday of each month at 5:30 pm and are held in the music room. All are welcome to attend.

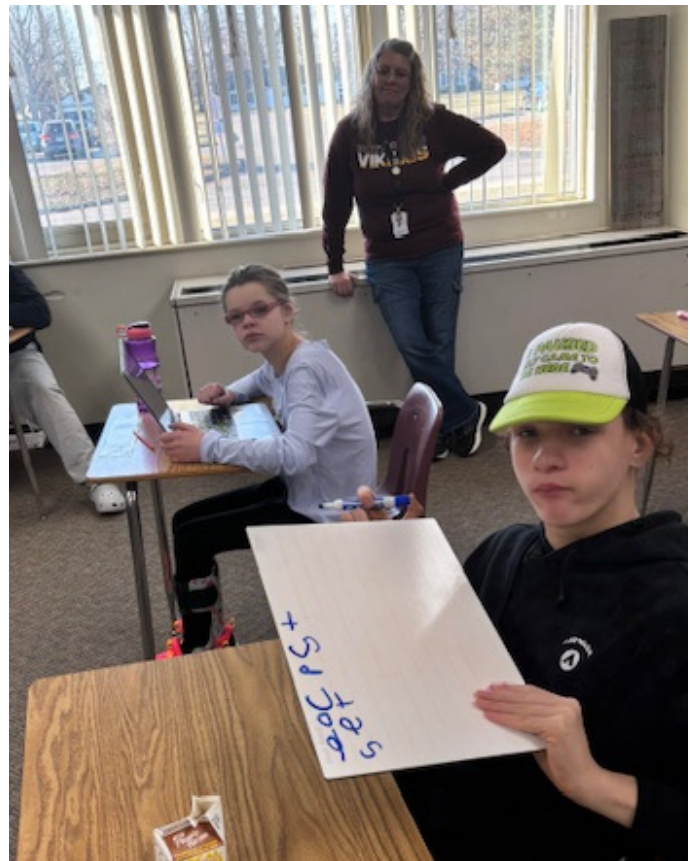
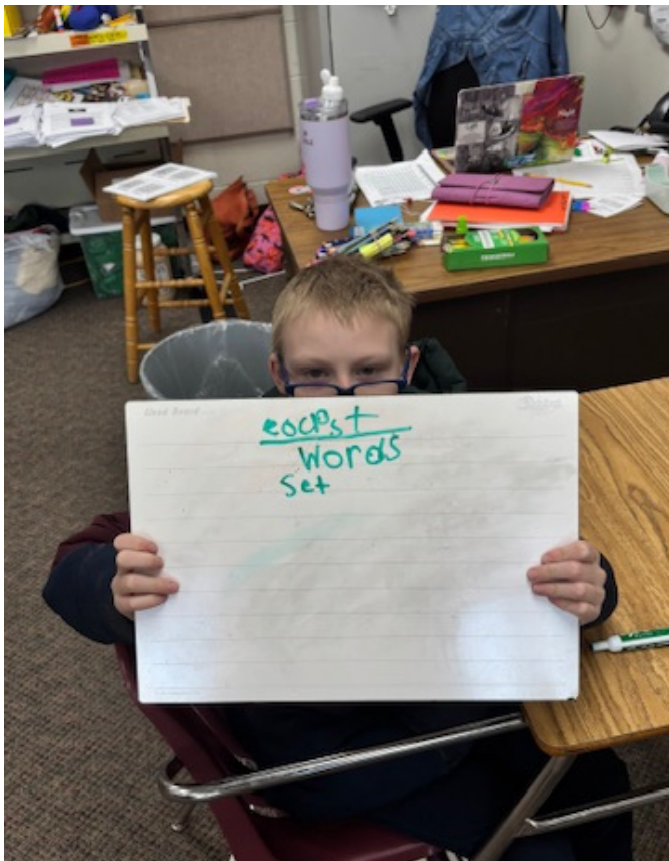
