Pottersville Public Schools is soliciting quotes/proposals for furniture for our Industry 4.0 classroom. The specifications include ED8-42" 8-seater base – high pressure laminate on casters. Base only dimensions: 24Wx60Lx40.5H. Overall dimensions with top: 48Wx84Lx42H. Comes with 8 metal stools and 6 storage bins with lids. Top is 1.5" UV coated, antimicrobial, solid maple butcher block top – 48Wx84Lx1.5" with magnets for mounting stools. No electrical. Combi Cam heavy duty combination cam locks for all doors with a master key override. Quantity 5.

Bid must include shipping/handling.
